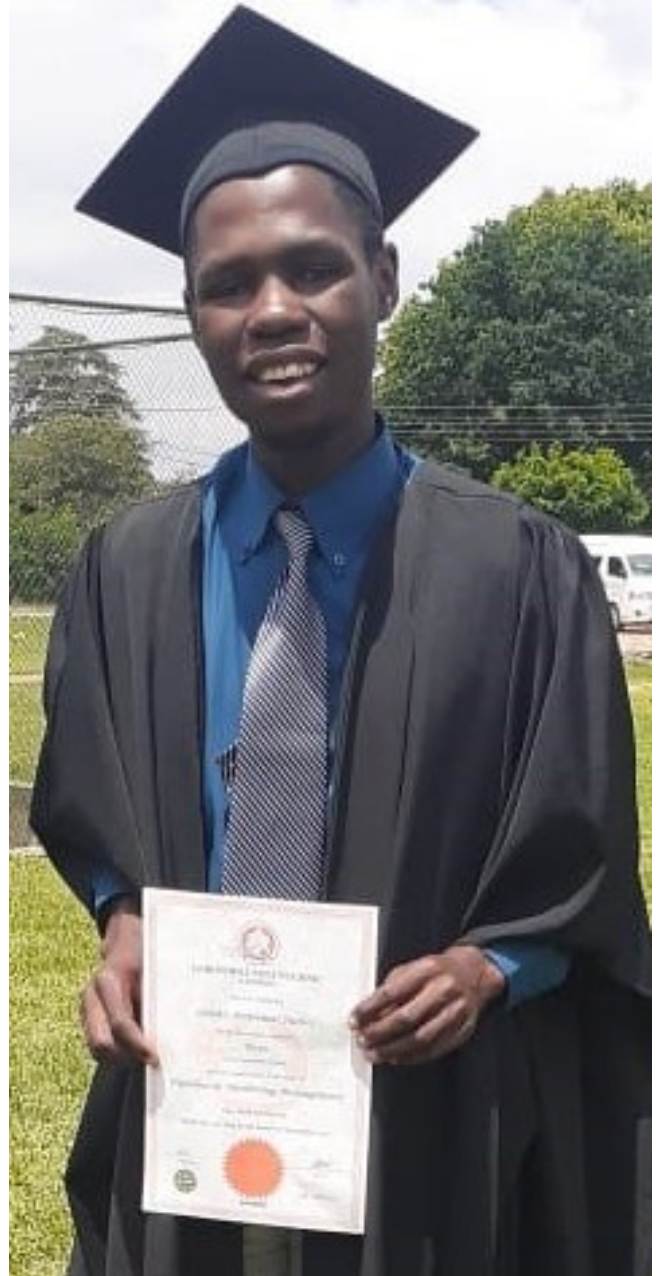


# Motsamai's Story

We supported Motsamai throughout his time at St. Agnes High School in Lesotho in 2014 and 2015. He has recently passed his Marketing Management degree with Distinction.

Motsamai lost his father at the age of 6 and his mother was forced to work in South Africa as a domestic worker to make ends meet. She was able to pay for him to go to our partner school in Lesotho, Ha Fusi but could not afford for him to go to high school. We supported him through his time at St. Agnes High School in 2014 and 2015. He was then able to progress on to Lerotholi Polytechnic without our support as the government provides free places at the national polytechnic.

Motsamai is helping children in his local area with their school work while he is looking for a job. We can't wait to hear what he does next!
